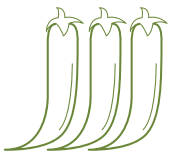

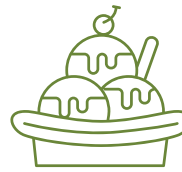

# COOKOFF RULES

Red Dirt Black Gold is held downtown in Heritage Plaza and the adjacent streets that surround the Plaza.

## **General**

- You may park to unload your vehicle, but no vehicles will be allowed to remain within the barricaded event area.
- No animals within the event area.
- Vendors shall not use tobacco products or vape within 25 feet of any display during the Festival.
- Always keep your area free of litter; make sure your area is clean before you leave

## **Day-Of Event Information & Hours of Operation**

- Booth set up time: Friday, September 30
- Ready-to-serve time: 5:00pm on Saturday, October 1
- Please prepare enough food for **50** plates

## **ICE:**

We will have an ice truck on site and will have bags of ice available. Free for corporate sponsors, \$4 for all other vendors.

## **ELECTRICITY:**

Electricity will be provided by generators and power within the parking lot.

## **PARKING:**

You will park your food trailer/ tent in the Heritage Plaza parking lot behind the Ocotillo Theater. It is located North of Main Street between 4th and Roselawn along Texas Ave. Leah Boone will have a map the day of to let you know where you will set up.
